Afternoon tea - who doesn't enjoy a brew and some cake, especially if it's helping to raise money for Once Upon a Smile.




B.I.N.G.O - there's a few more inventive ways to play the game these days. But remember, gamble responsibly!

Working at the CAR WASH -do do do do do do do. Get out your buckets and sponges and get washing your colleagues' cars at work.








The classics always work! Ask everyone to donate a set amount to dress down for the day (or try dress up day too!). A great idea for work or school.

Pub Quizzes are already a lot of fun and even more so these days people are turning to online quiz evenings. Why not host your own?




Quit something? If you love to do something, then get sponsored to quit. It could be for a day, a week, a month or a year.




Contact a range of businesses, retailers and more and ask for donations. You can then arrange your very own raffle.


Ultra event-take part in one of the amazing challenge events that take place throughout the UK<u>-see our events page for details!</u>
